

Form X – Use of Crown Foreshore: Provincial and Port Metro Vancouver Authorization



The Province of British Columbia and Port Metro Vancouver are responsible for the administration, management and land use control of the Crown foreshore within their respective jurisdictions. If your application involves the Crown foreshore (e.g. along the Fraser River), please provide, as part of your application, documents showing that you have obtained authorization, such as a permit, a licence, or a water lease, from the Province or Port Metro Vancouver.

Developments that require such authorization include but are not limited to:

- new float home or float home relocation
- construction of a new building or structure
- addition or modification to an existing building or structure
- construction of a dock
- demolition of a building or structure
- change of use
- land reclamation
- dredging, including deepening of a channel or water lot
- new utility corridor.
