Once the Demolition Permit has been issued, the applicant must schedule the applicable inspections in the order listed:	
1. If any service connections to the building, Capping of Services: Inspector will attend the site, determining that the services (Sanitary, Storm, and/or Water) have been disconnected and capped in an approved manner. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The applicant must expose and disconnect/cap the sanitary, storm and water services at the property line and must place marker stakes to identify the location of the services as follows: Water (Blue); Sanitary (Red); Storm (Green). The capping of services inspection must be passed before the applicant is permitted to proceed with demolishing the structure. 	
2. Demolition Inspection: Inspector will attend the site, determining that the lot is clear and all conditions of the Demolition Permit have been met.
