

## Insurance Requirements for Crane Over-Swing

Crane over-swing in the airspace above the City of Delta's Highway may be permitted via a Highway Use Permit. One of the supporting documents that is required for a Highway Use Permit is a Certificate of Insurance, **with the City of Delta named as additional insured**. The insurance requirements are listed below:

<b>Risk</b>	<b>Examples</b>	<b>Required Insurance Per Crane Swing Occurrence*</b>
<b>Low</b>	No major structures nearby E.g.: Sheds, single non-commercial property	\$5 Million
<b>Medium</b>	Low value structures nearby E.g.: Single-family houses, low density residential structures, small bridges	\$10 Million
<b>High</b>	High value structures nearby E.g.: Commercial areas, high rises, larger bridges	\$20 Million

\*Before obtaining insurance, it is recommended that the applicant discusses their project with the City to confirm the required amount.

The purpose of obtaining the insurance is to indemnify and protect the City of Delta against liability for all damages, including third party infrastructure, business interruption expenses, injury, or loss of life. Insurance shall include the operations of developers, contractors, subcontractors, and all other persons at the developer's property.
